Strategy Description

- ▶ The Fund strategically diversifies across an array of uncorrelated strategies, each managed by Trium's experienced investment teams, combining them into a risk managed, capital-efficient, portfolio aiming for uncorrelated performance whilst protecting investors' capital.
- ▶ Targets Cash plus 5% annualized net return, < 5% annualized volatility, and average zero beta to the MSCI ACWI Index over a market cycle. The underlying strategies span: Relative Value, Global Macro, Equity Market Neutral and Event Driven.
- ▶ The Head of Multi-Strategy is responsible for Portfolio Construction, with oversight provided by the Trium Multi-Strategy Committee. Independent Risk Management is undertaken by the Trium Risk team, headed by Marina Tsikoura (Chief Risk Officer).

Monthly Commentary

The Trium Multi-Strategy UCITS Fund was up +0.3% in July, taking 2025 YTD returns to +6.8% (E USD), on track to exceed the Fund's Cash +5% annual target return again this year, following doing so in 2024.

The Fund saw increased AUM coming from capital inflows and positive performance. This capital was selectively tilted to four of our nine strategies where the Multi-Strategy team sees a strong relative opportunity set:

- ▶ Quantitative EMN – the strategy has delivered strong performance over the past 12 years with a diversified approach and low cross-correlation to our discretionary EMN and other strategies.
- ▶ Global Macro (Thematic) – this strategy performed very strongly in June, rewarding a capital increase made at the end of May, and we allocated further capital to this strategy in July. The strategy is uncorrelated to both equity markets and to our other Global Macro strategy. It also has very low cross-correlation to the other seven strategies.
- ▶ Discretionary EMN (Energy transition industries-focused) – The strategy has a negative/low correlation to our other eight strategies. It performed strongly in Q2 and, with wide dispersion in its sectors of focus, we see a rich forward-looking opportunity set.
- ▶ Convertible Bond Arbitrage – the strategy has generated positive returns with negative correlation to equities over the past year and has low cross-correlation to our other strategies. The Portfolio Managers expect a strong new issuance calendar and are finding idiosyncratic arbitrage opportunities.

The Fund ended the month with allocation leverage of 175.9%.

Summary

The Fund demonstrated the strength of its diversified approach. Strategies that have been performing well in H1, notably our Quant EMN and Discretionary Global Macro (Trading) strategies, recorded negative returns in July, as did, to a lesser extent, two of our discretionary EMN strategies. However, these losses were more than offset by positive performance from our other five strategies, with our Systematic Macro RV and our Catalyst-driven Discretionary equity market neutral strategies generating particularly strong returns.

Global Macro

Our thematic global macro strategy followed a solid June with a further *(Continued Overleaf)*

month of well-diversified gains. Short-term Hong Kong Dollar (HKD) rates trading made the most significant contribution to P&L after the Fund added back to its position that had been the major contributor in the prior month, too. The strategy benefited from synthetic exposure to precious metals and from positions in carbon emissions, where the Fund is long in both California (as a distressed play) and the EU (on short-term supply and demand dynamics). The Fund also benefited from positions in Chinese equity indices. Gains were somewhat offset by losses on US positions. The market reduced expectation of US rate cuts to just -25bps for the rest of 2025, while the Epynt team is positioned for larger cuts. Its expectation of a weaker US Dollar resulted in losses on positions as the USD rallied by +3% vs the Brazilian Real.

Our trading-oriented discretionary global macro strategy had a negative month. It was positioned to benefit in a Risk-Off market with long CDS positions that tightened over the month. These positions have strong asymmetric properties and may be expected to perform strongly in a sell-off. The strategy was positioned to profit from a weaker USD in both DM and EM and so made losses as the DXY rallied. Rates, both in DM and EM, also contributed negatively this month. This strategy is still the strongest contributor to the Fund's returns YTD.

Event Driven

Our hard catalyst Merger Arbitrage focused strategy had another positive month. The Portfolio Manager has increased his capital deployment, following strong M&A activity in July, even in Europe. There was significant activity in the US, too. Led by Union Pacific's \$88bn acquisition of Norfolk Southern, there were 3 large-cap US \$10bn+ deals for public companies announced in July, versus just 5 for the entire first half of the year. The Portfolio Manager is focusing on shorter-dated opportunities and has a well-diversified book to seek to ensure strong risk-adjusted returns, with good downside protection.

Equity Market Neutral

Our discretionary catalyst-driven EMN strategy performed strongly. Returns were driven by a small number of US stocks where the Portfolio Manager has identified catalysts for strong earnings growth and stock price appreciation.

Our two Discretionary EMN strategies, which focus on industries most affected by the energy transition and identify companies capable of generating profits while reducing their carbon and other emissions or contributing to climate solutions, were modestly down in July, following a strong increase in June.

Our Quantitative EMN strategy, after six straight months of positive returns, had its first negative month of 2025. July was generally a tough month for Quant Equity funds as the reduction in hedge fund net and gross exposures temporarily impacted positions and led to a low-quality or so-called 'junk' rally. The Fund did a reasonable job of preserving capital during this event with a limited intra-month loss and a quick recovery afterwards. The top-performing model group was Stock Sentiment, followed by Stock Persistence. Beta Arb, Stat Arb, and Quantamental underperformed - within Quantamental, Valuation and Quality characteristics were penalised with Growth being rewarded.

Relative Value

Our Systematic Macro RV strategy was the strongest performing strategy in July. Strategies across all asset classes were positive on the month, with FX strategies being the largest contributor. Within the VIX space, alpha came from momentum strategies. In Commodities, the natural gas strategy was a main contributor.

Our Convertible Bond Arbitrage strategy contributed positively to the Fund's returns. The biggest contributor was Ocado (0.75% 2027). The company continues to produce in-line earnings, and the credit has tightened. Delivery Hero and ITRI were also good performers. On the negative side, BIDU/TRIP (0% 2032 declined), and BAC/SAP (0.1% 2030) traded lower. The new issuance calendar was robust, with Japan leading the way through Nissan (1% 2031) with \$1.4 billion. In total, Asia accounted for \$5.2 billion in new deals, the U.S. for \$3.6 billion, and Europe for €375 million. Credit markets remain firm, with high levels of single-stock volatility providing a supportive backdrop.

Outlook

The Fund continues to benefit from its structural advantages. The very low levels of cross-correlation that the nine distinct strategies, driven by differentiated risk factors, have with each other allow the Multi-Strategy team to employ allocation leverage, which has been successful in boosting returns while incurring minimal incremental fund-level volatility. Allocation decisions to tilt additional capital to particular strategies in a nimble, same-day timeframe have also added to returns. The Fund's portfolio construction evolves incrementally depending on the views of the multi-strategy team on the respective opportunity sets for each strategy. This has been successful in increasing Fund returns compared to those that would have been realised had the Fund's strategies been equally-weighted.

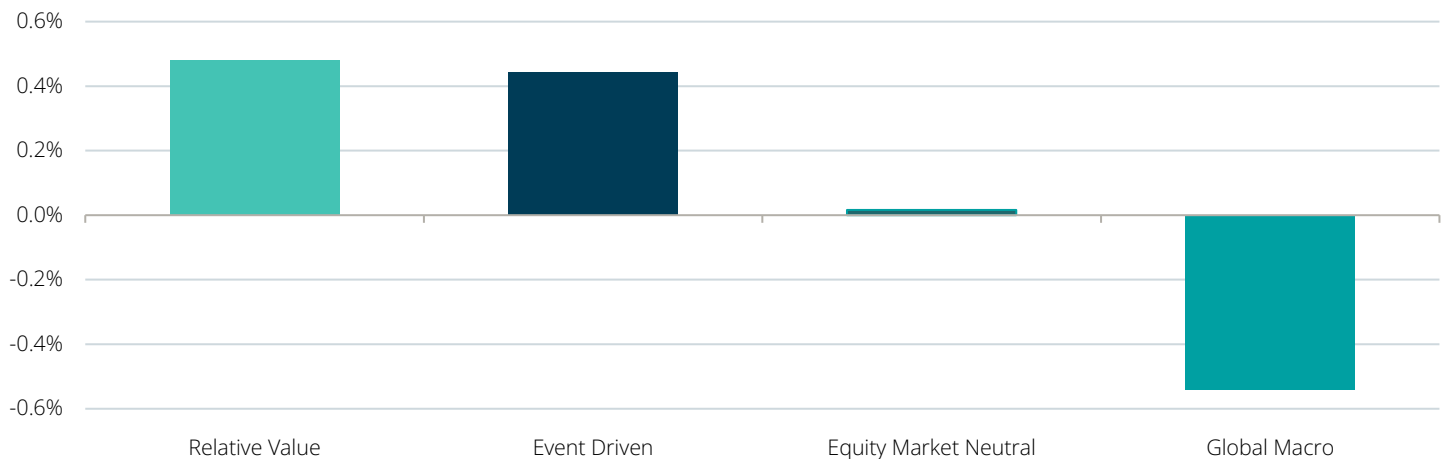

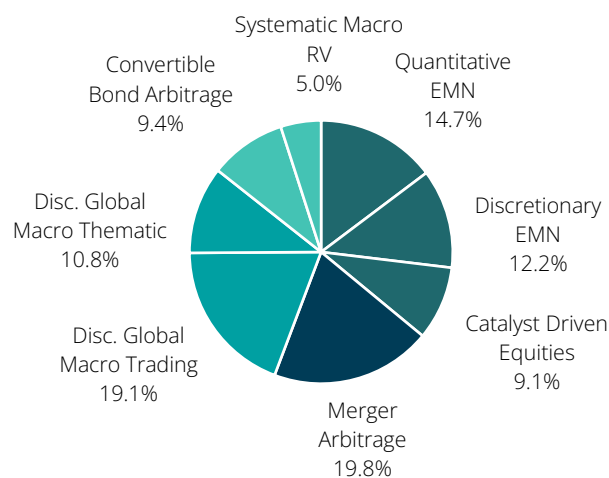

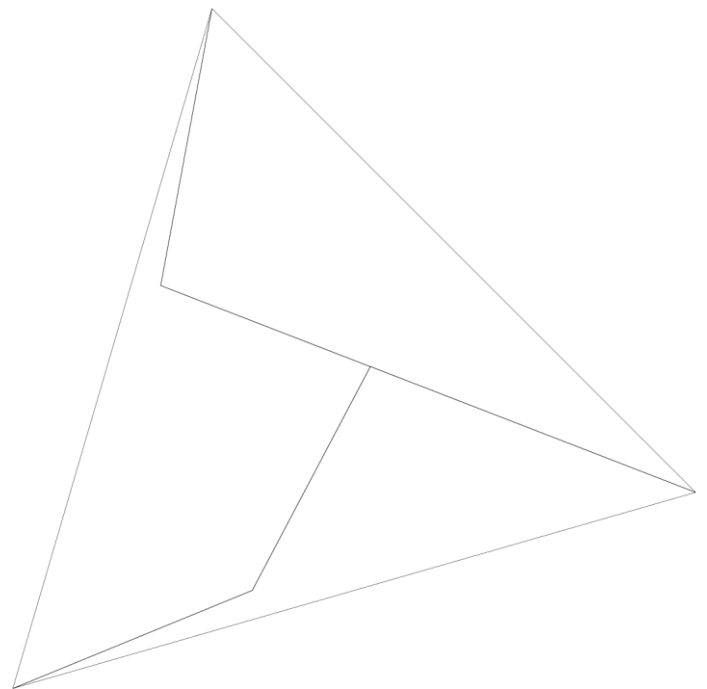
